

 - DIABETIC SCREENING ON PAGE 2 MUST BE COMPLETED BY PROVIDER
 - FORM MUST BE SIGNED AND DATED WITHIN ONE YEAR PRECEDING THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL (ON OR AFTER AUGUST 23, 2022)

DOCUMENTATION SHOWING THAT YOUR CHILD IS UP TO DATE ON ALL REQUIRED IMMUNIZATIONS INCLUDING ONE DOSE OF THE FOLLOWING VACCINES ON OR AFTER THE 11TH BIRTHDAY:

- MENINGOCOCCAL CONJUGATE VACCINE

THE *PREFERRED* DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING THESE RECORDS TO POWERSCHOOL IN THE "HEALTH OFFICE DOCUMENTATION" TAB IS <u>AUGUST 4, 2023.</u>

Students <u>not in compliance</u> with this regulation on or before Sunday, October 15, 2023 will be excluded from school attendance beginning Monday, October 16th, 2032.

SPORTS FORMS FOR OUR INTERSCHOLASTIC TEAMS

NTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS PERMISSION FORM/HEALTH PACKET - CAN BE FOUND ON THE D64 HEALTH SERVICES PAGE UNDER THE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS SECTION. THIS INCLUDES:

- DOCUMENTATION OF A PHYSICAL EXAM PERFORMED WITHIN 395 DAYS PRIOR TO THE START OF THE SPORT AND MUST BE VALID FOR THE DURATION OF THE SEASON.
- SIGNED PARENT PERMISSION FORM
- MUST BE SUBMITTED TO POWERSCHOOL UNDER THE "ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT DOCUMENTS" TAB AT A MINIMUM <u>THE DAY BEFORE TRYOUTS</u>.
 - THESE FORMS MUST BE UPLOADED TO POWERSCHOOL BY THE PARENT SO THAT THEY CAN BE CHECKED OFF BY THE ATHLETIC DIRECTOR. THESE FORMS NO LONGER COME THROUGH THE HEALTH OFFICE.


