Halloween Dress Guidelines

The Student Government Association (SGA) has provided an opportunity for students to wear costumes at Lincoln on Tuesday, October 31, 2023. Students must donate one dollar in order to participate. While we as a staff try to keep distractions to the learning environment to a minimum, we will allow this practice with the guidelines listed below.

Costumes must:

- Adhere to the District dress code
- Be respectful, appropriate, and be of a non-violent nature
- Not contain any weapons (real or look-alike). This includes but is not limited to swords, guns, knives, clubs, lasers, etc.
- Cover the student appropriately.
- Hats and head coverings will be allowed if they are part of the student costume.
- Students must be recognizable no face paint or full face masks. Face masks for health and safety must continue to be worn.
- Costumes cannot display any drug, alcohol, or cigarette logos or references.

Any student wearing a questionable costume will be referred to the office and administration. If costumes are inappropriate, the student may be subject to disciplinary consequences and, at the very least, be required to change into other clothing items.

NOTE: Lincoln Middle School and District 64 are committed to providing an inclusive and safe environment for all of our students. We ask that you and your student please be mindful and to refrain from costumes that can be considered offensive or insensitive. Specifically, students should avoid costumes with cultural/ethnic/racial appropriation and /or costumes depicting individuals whose life/work represent values and qualities counter to those of the District and the school.

Student Absences and Missed Work

Work will be given upon return for students leaving the country or immediate District area when your children RETURN to school. It must be completed at home under a parent's supervision. Teachers are not expected to provide homework or assignments in advance for students who will be absent for an extended period of time for a family vacation and other activities.

When students are home sick or absent for a valid cause, students may make up missed homework and classwork assignments in a reasonable timeframe upon return. Parents and students can keep up on assignments via Schoology. Teachers are not expected to provide work in advance, and parents are encouraged to be in contact with the teachers to establish a timeframe for classwork/assignments.

Bus Tracking App Now Available

We are excited to start offering a way for families to securely track the exact bus location to monitor where their child is during the morning pickup and afternoon bus drop-offs. Starting Monday, October 2nd, 2023, families can use the Zonar MyView app to see the live location of their child's bus.

As we begin using the software and app, this improvement to our transportation process will only be available to the families of bus riders at Field Elementary School and Lincoln Middle School. The rest of the schools will be added later this school year. We ask that once families download and use the app, they fill out <u>this</u> <u>feedback survey</u> so that the District Office can monitor how the app rollout is going.

Student Calls to Parents

Please remember that students are not allowed to use cell phones during school hours. Phones are available in the main office for student use. Students calling to report illness should be directed to first visit the school nurse. Our school nurse is available to see your child and can often help with their current discomfort or symptoms.
